### Introduction

This document will define what “cookies” are, what they do, and how the data they are collecting is used when you visit our website.

### Defining Cookies

Kaspersky defines a cookie as “text files with small pieces of data that are used to identify your computer as you use a computer network.” This is to identify you as a user and the device you are using to help us understand how you interact with our website. Cookies are either stored in your browser or on the local hard disc of your personal computer. You have the right to either accept or decline cookies. Some cookies are essential to a functional and favourable user-experience.

### Types of Cookies and what they are used for

There are different types of Cookies to help us achieve the below-mentioned purposes.

- Functional Cookies help us make sure the website functions properly.
- Analytics Cookies help us understand how the website is performing and how users interact with the website’s content. This data also gives us insight into what content users prefer.
- Advertising Cookies help us promote content based on your interests, behaviour, and pages you have viewed for example.
- Social Media Cookies integrate with social media platforms such as Facebook and enable us to share website content on this platform.

We use cookies for various purposes which include the following:

- Making sure the website is functioning properly;
- Improving the performance of the website;
- Improving the user experience on the website;
- Understanding how users interact with the website and what content they prefer;
- Promoting content on social media that might be of interest to you.

### Your right to accept or decline Cookies.

You have control over which Cookies are placed on your browser and/or personal computer. Therefore, you can either accept or reject these Cookies. Please note that Functional Cookies are vital to make sure the website functions properly.
